Boccia named Association of Division III Independents baseball Player of the Week

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – St. Joseph’s College (N.Y.) freshman shortstop Joseph Boccia (Westwood, N.J.) is this week’s Association of Division III Independents baseball Player of the Week. Boccia helped the Bears to a 4-0 record on the week as he compiled a .545 batting average, a .615 on-base percentage and a 1.182 slugging percentage. He recorded six hits, five of which were for extra bases, scored six runs and drove in five. In a win over St. Paul’s College, Boccia went 2-for-3 with three runs, three RBI and a double and he is currently on a five-game hitting streak.

Swaja selected as Association of Division III Independents softball Player of the Week

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – University of Dallas senior pitcher/infielder Jessica “Belle” Swaja (Hillsboro, Ore.) has been named the Association of Division III Independents softball Player of the Week. In four games, Swaja went 9-for-15 (.600), including four doubles and a triple, three RBI and six runs scored. Her slugging percentage was 1.000 on 15 total bases. On the mound, she picked up a victory in 11 innings of work and recorded a shutout while surrendering only two earned runs in two complete-game starts. She tallied a 1.27 ERA on the week.
